Eduroam Wi-Fi can be used to connect devices to Wi-Fi on the Borders College Campuses. You must have either a staff or student account to be able to do so.

Windows computers

1. Forget the Eduroam connection.

2. Find Eduroam WIFi and click connect.


3. Use your Borders College credentials:

username: 0012345@borderscollege.ac.uk or 0012345@students.borderscollege.ac.uk

password: Your college password

4. When asked whether you wish to continue connecting, click 'Show Certificate Details' and check that the certificate has been issued to sbc-nps03.borderscollege.ac.uk. Once you're satisfied that the certificate is correct, click 'Connect'.

5. Wait for Eduroam to connect.



Mobile Devices

- 1. Connect to the Internet and download the **GetEduroam** App from device's app store.
- 2. Forget the existing Eduroam Wi-Fi network (if it's already saved)
- 3. Open the new **GetEduroam** App.
- 4. In the **Institution field**, find Borders College.
- 5. Enter your credentials

username: 0012345@borderscollege.ac.uk or 0012345@students.borderscollege.ac.uk password: Your college password

- 6. You should now see 'Enjoy using Eduroam, WiFi is now configured on your device'.
- 7. Close the App.
- 8. If in range of Eduroam you should be automatically connected, however, if not find the network manually and press connect.
